First Time Socks (Amy) \$55
Have you always wanted to try knitting socks but were a wee bit intimidated? Come to this class and discover how approachable they are. We will learn the anatomy and construction of a traditional cuff-down sock by knitting a small sample sock. We will cover all aspects of knitting a cuff-down sock before moving on to an adult pair of your very own. Pattern provided in class fee.

Grannie Square Refresher & Joining with Crochet (Julie) \$20
If you know your basic crochet stitches Julie will provide a refresher on grannie squares and then concentrate on how to link them together as you go so there is minimal or no seaming at the end.

Interweave Knits Tee (Laura) \$70
This sweet summer sleeveless pullover is constructed in a modular method. We'll knit one motif in the round and then pick up stitches along the finished motif to start the next one. A picot neck edge finishes this lovely garment. For the adventuresome (and advanced) knitter.

Intro to Crochet (Laura) \$20
Learn the basics of crochet. Whether you want to use crochet techniques in your knitting, or just want to learn crochet, this afternoon session will get you started and prepare you for the next step.

Intro to Entrelac Knitting (Laura) \$50
Learn the magic of Entrelac (lattice knitting). You will complete a felted drawstring pouch while perfecting your Entrelac technique. Must be able to knit and purl with confidence. Pattern, yarn and leather cords provided in class fee.

Intro to Knitting (Laura) \$35

Kudo Placket Pullover Sweater (Amy) \$55
Plymouth Kudo is a lovely cotton-silk-rayon blend yarn with long color repeats giving a beautiful Noro-like effect. It's perfect for spring! In this class we will knit this pullover using Kudo. The sweater is worked in an unusual way in one piece and has a button placket. We will also discuss making minor changes to the pattern for a good fit. Pattern provided in class fee.

Class Enrollment Notes & Policy

Class size:

- We require a minimum of three students to hold a class. Most classes will be limited to no more than six students to allow you sufficient time with the instructor.

Class enrollment:

- We ask that you pre-pay your class enrollment as a courtesy to the instructor.

- **No refunds will be made if you cancel your enrollment.**

- Please check your schedules carefully before enrolling in classes. We will refund your enrollment fee if a class is cancelled due to low enrollment.

- We encourage you to send in a check, or stop by the store. You will NOT be considered enrolled until you have paid.

- **We no longer take credit cards over the phone for class enrollments.**

If you call the shop, we are happy to pencil you in however you will NOT be considered enrolled until you have paid for your class.

- It is your responsibility to attend all classes in a multi-session program. Unfortunately **class makeup sessions are not available.**

(If you need to miss a class you may consider spending some 1-1 time with the instructor at \$10/half hour.)

- If a class is full we would be happy to put you on a waitlist for that particular date. You will ONLY be called if an opening for that class date becomes available.

Class materials discount:

- You will receive a 10% discount on class materials. We do ask that you purchase the materials at Creative Fibers LLC as outlined by the instructor for the class.

- If during the class you find that the needles you purchased for that class don't provide the correct gauge we will be happy to exchange them for another size as long as you have your receipt and the original needle package is intact.

Class cancellations:

- We will try our best to reschedule classes cancelled due to poor weather conditions. (Hopefully we won't have any at this time of year!)
