This sweet cap-sleeved sweater is knit from the top down and has the option to be a pullover or a cardigan. If you've never knit a top-down garment before this class may be for you. We will learn the basic construction of a top-down sweater and how to pick up stitches for a neckline and sleeves. Abigail is flattering on a variety of body shapes and is a versatile addition to any wardrobe. Pattern included in the class fee.

Button Button Sock (Julie) \$55

This shop favorite is sure to please! Experience the joy of a short-legged sock while combining two colors of Koigu and/or Claudia Handpaint. Learn the wonderful technique of an eyelet buttonhole, which may be used in many applications. No prior sock experience needed. Pattern included in the class fee.

Children's Mittens (Julie) \$35

Custom Fit Skirt (Laura) \$50

Laura has knit two skirt designs; both featuring a bit of lace at the hem. Both are knit from the bottom up allowing for custom fitting. Take your pick of designs and then select a yarn. Make it a summer skirt or a winter skirt based on the yarn you select. **Note:** Skirt pattern/yarn is **not** included in the class fee.

Custom Fit Sweater (Laura) \$65

Have you knit a sweater and then been disappointed that it didn't fit well? In this class we'll explore our individual sizing prior to starting a sweater project. Choose from a simple pullover or the slightly fitted Avocet B open cardigan from Berroco. Both feature set in sleeves which are not as challenging as you may think. We'll make adjustments to the pattern for our size and shape (useful knowledge for all your sweater knitting) and then get knitting. Pattern, yarn and needles are **not** included in the class fee and will vary depending upon style chosen for class.

Easy Crochet Koigu Scarf (Laura) \$25

This lacy scarf just uses the chain stitch, single and double crochet. Make it in one color, or stripe it like Laura's using multiple colors. This is a perfect project to perfect your basic crochet stitches. Pattern included in the class fee.

First Time Socks (Amy) \$55

Have you been curious or even intimidated about knitting socks? In this class we will learn the basic structure of a sock knitted from the cuff down. We will learn step-by-step to knit a sample sock from a pattern before embarking on our own unique pair of socks. We will also learn some general guidelines about sock knitting that will help us with any sock pattern. Attendance at all four sessions is important. Pattern included in the class fee.

Not your grandmother's granny square! Today's yarns transform this classic motif into something truly special. This is a great class to perfect your basic crochet stitches. We will discuss the causes of some of these issues and learn how to avoid them in the future. The entire sequence will be done sitting in a chair or standing. You do not need to be flexible or have experience with yoga to benefit from this class.
